

The Hertfordshire Golf Club Golf Day Terms and Conditions

Terms of Booking

- A Deposit is required to confirm the Booking and reserve the Tee times.
- The Final number of guests must be confirmed seven days in advance of the Society date. In the event that the Society is cancelled by the hirer, the deposit is non-refundable
- Should guest numbers be smaller on the day, the original food charge, as per the booking form, will still be incurred
- If a deposit is not provided, the Club has the right to utilise this booking time for another event
- Full balance of the Society should be paid on or before the reserved date

Golf is played, for the most part, without the supervision of a referee or umpire. The game relies on the integrity of the individual to show consideration for other players, care for the course and to abide by the Rules. All players should conduct themselves in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy and sportsmanship at all times, irrespective of how competitive they may be.

Etiquette is an integral and inextricable part of the game, which has come to define golf's values worldwide.

Put simply, it is a series of guidelines that exist to show other players, whether through divot repair or awareness of your shadow, a degree of fairness which you would expect to receive in return.

Pace of Play

To ensure maximum enjoyment for all golfers, members of the society must adhere to the Hertfordshire's recommended pace of play which is 4hrs for 18 holes. The Course Marshall reserves the right to move any group to any part of the course in order for the said group to regain their correct position on the course.

Weather Conditions

In the event of frost, snow, fog or heavy rain during the days prior to your event please contact the Pro Shop on 01992 466666 ext 227. In addition, please call the day before and the morning of your event to be advised of the condition of the course and if buggies and trolleys are allowed.

Conditions of Play

Play will be in a four-ball format playing off the yellow tees at eight minute intervals. Other formats will only be accepted with prior agreement from the Club.

Course Etiquette

It is the responsibility of the organiser to ensure that his/her guests are aware of the standard etiquette of golf. Failure to comply with this will result in the individuals being removed from the golf course.

Dress Code

The Hertfordshire does not permit blue denim of any kind, combat trousers or shorts, halter necks, collarless or sleeveless shirts. Tailored shorts of traditional length are acceptable. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. A smart informal dress code applies in the Clubhouse.

Buggies

Golf buggy hire is to be paid in full on the day or prior to the event. Buggies are the responsibility of the organiser and he/she will be liable for any damage incurred to the buggy or the course. Availability will be dependent on the condition of the course.

Markers

If you require markers for a Longest Drive & Nearest the Pin on the day, a fully refundable deposit of £5 per pin will be required.

Crown Open Play Members

Open Play members are entitled to play in societies with a 40% discount on the Green fee element of the booking. All food items and other services will be charged for in full.
